## BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY, STORMWATER MANAGEMENT MEETING MINUTES CITY OF HARTFORD CITY, INDIANA FEBRUARY 22, 2022

**CALL TO ORDER AND WELCOME:** Mayor Dan Eckstein welcomed everyone and called to order the regular meeting of the Board of Works and Public Safety at 5:00pm.

**ROLL CALL:** Members present were Ms. Kristi Bonewit and Mayor Dan Eckstein. Ms. Pam Weiseman was absent. City Attorney, Brandon Murphy and Clerk-Treasurer, Dana Whatley were also present.

**APPROVAL OF AGENDA:** Ms. Bonewit made a motion to approve the agenda as submitted. Mayor Eckstein seconded the motion. The vote to approve was 2-0-1.

## APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

- **A.) MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING FROM FEBRUARY 7, 2022:** Mayor Eckstein made a motion to accept the minutes of the special meeting as submitted. Ms. Bonewit seconded the motion. The vote to approve was 2-0-1.
- B.) **MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING FROM FEBRUARY 7, 2022:** Mayor Eckstein made a motion to accept the minutes of the regular meeting as submitted. Ms. Bonewit seconded the motion. The vote to approve was 2-0-1.

**APPROVAL OF CLAIMS:** Ms. Bonewit made a motion to accept the claims totaling \$464,194.43 as submitted. Mayor Eckstein seconded the motion. The vote to approve was 2-0-1.

## **OLD BUSINESS:**

**A.**) **M.M. EXTENDED LEAVE:** Employee M.M. provided an updated doctor's note states this employee will be having surgery and will have a recovery time of 4 to 6 months. Mayor Eckstein made a motion to approve leave through April 18, 2022 pending receipt of an updated doctor's note. Ms. Bonewit seconded the motion. The vote to approve was 2-0-1.

## **NEW BUSINESS:**

- **A.) OPEN SEALED BIDS FOR CASH FARM LEASE:** The City of Hartford City received two sealed bids for the cash farm lease. The following bids were opened:
  - **1.) JONATHAN BOLE** The bid was submitted for \$255 per acre.
  - **2.) LIGHT FARMS** The bid was submitted for \$345 per acre.

After the bids were read aloud, Mr. Bole requested that the floor be opened for oral bidding. Mayor Eckstein made a motion to open the floor for oral bidding. Ms. Bonewit seconded the motion. The vote to approve was 2-0-1.

Oral bidding was done with the final bid going to Light Farms for \$370 per acre for one year.

- **B.**) **DANA WHATLEY TRENT JONES WITH MVH DEPARTMENT:** Ms. Whatley explained that Mr. Jeff Thomas was unable to attend tonight's meeting and that Mr. Jones has obtained his CDL license and he is now due for a .25 cent per hour pay increase effective 2/21/22. Ms. Bonewit made the motion to approve this pay increase. Mayor Eckstein seconded the motion. The vote to approve was 2-0-1.
- C.) HARTFORD CITY HEALTH CLUB MEMBERSHIP FEE INCREASE: Clerk-Treasurer Whatley explained that the Hartford City Health Club has advised us that the membership fee will be going from \$30 a month to \$40 beginning April 2022. Currently the City pays ½ of the fee and the employee pays the other ½. Ms. Whatley asked if the City wants to continue to pay ½ of the increased fee. Mayor Eckstein made a motion to continue to have the City to pay ½ of the membership fee. Ms. Bonewit seconded the motion. The vote to approve was 2-0-1.
